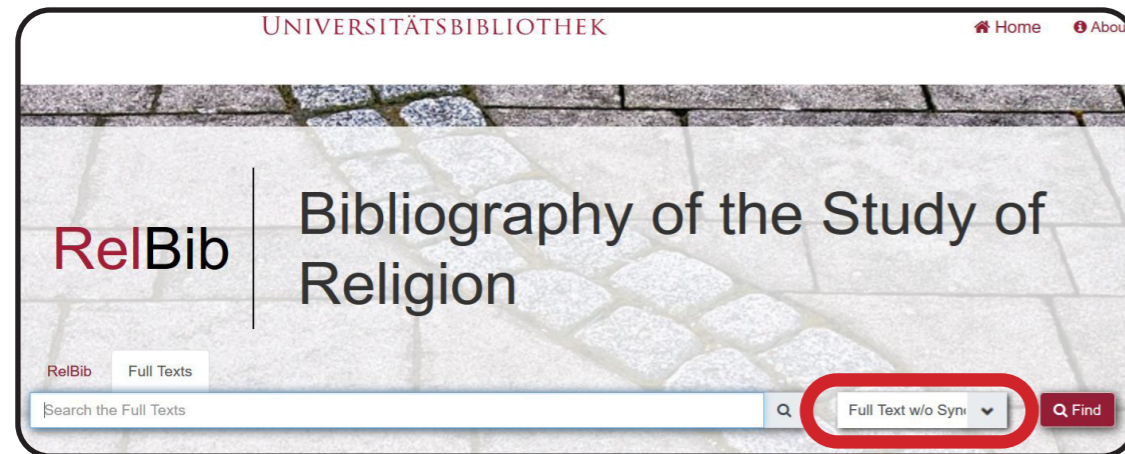




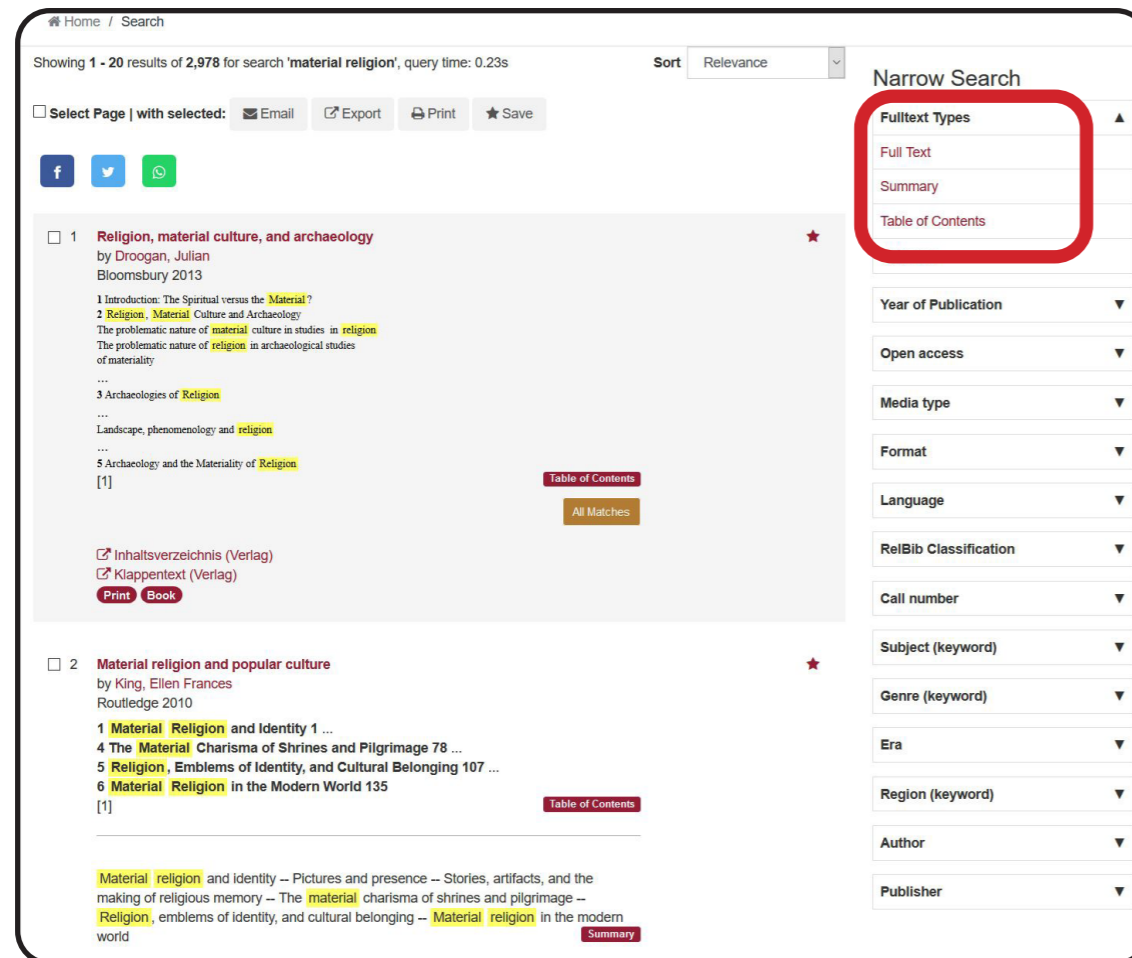
RelBib Full Text Search

The full text search significantly expands and modernises your **search strategy** in RelBib. It offers the possibility of a **direct and precise search** for individual words and phrases in a large **digital text corpus**.

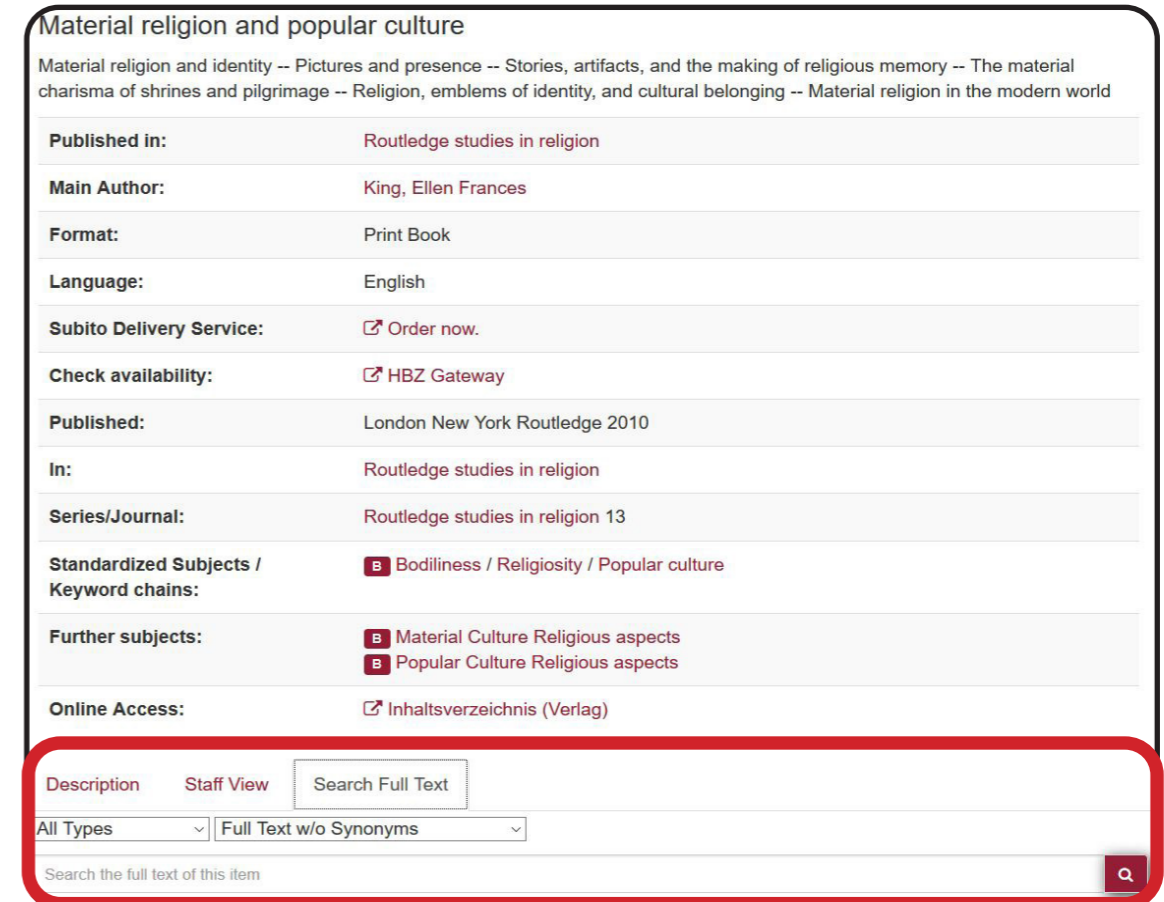
In addition to a free text search, **synonyms** of a search term and their **translations** in several languages are also available. The selection is made simply by using the selection menu to the right of the search bar.



The search can also be restricted to individual **types of texts** (i.e. table of contents, full text, abstract) and combined with the **RelBib facets**.



It is also possible to search the full text of a **selected individual title**.



The full text search is offered for **commercial** and **open access** content relevant to the study of religion. One of the benefits of the RelBib full text search lies in the fact that – for the first time in an open access environment – **resources** from different publishers, which are **subject to subscription**, can be searched simultaneously and **legally**.

So far, the publishers **Brill** and **Mohr Siebeck** have been won as pilot partners. Please note that the full text search is therefore currently only possible for a limited part of the titles indexed in RelBib.
